New students will receive a welcome email that contains their user name and password.

If you have forgotten your password:

- 1. Go to Wesportal and click on the Wesnet tab, select Password Management
- 2. Enter your personal information on the Password Recovery screen
- 3. You will receive an email at your personal email address with a link to reset your password

To change your password:

- 4. Go to Wesportal and log into the portal. Once you are logged in go to Wesnet, Password Management
- 5. Complete the information on the Password Reset screen (follow password guidelines on screen)
- 6. Select a reset action: You can reset both your Wesportal password and your email password or you can chose which one to reset.

How to access Canvas

- 1. Go to Wesportal
- 2. Type your user name and password
- 3. Click the Sign in button
- 4. Select My Courses from left menu
- 5. Select a course from the list
- 6. Type your Wesportal user name and password in the boxes
- 7. Once logged into Canvas you can go to the Dashboard to see all your courses

How to sign in to your student email

- Go to <u>Wesportal</u>, select the Quicklink for Wesleyan Google email
