

## **TEAS ENTRANCE EXAM**

**Q: *What is the TEAS?***

A: The TEAS is a pre-admission exam for the BSN program at Wesleyan College which is administered and scored by a computer.

**Q: *Is there a fee?***

A: Yes. There is a non-refundable, non-transferable fee of \$80.00 per exam. This will be paid online at: <https://wesportal.wesleyancollege.edu>. “Pay Online Nursing Entrance Exam”

**Q: *Do I receive information about the test after I submit my TEAS reservation fee?***

A: Yes. You will receive a confirmation email from the Nursing Office within five business days of your reservation.

**Q: *How long is the test?***

A: A total of 209 minutes will be allotted for the exam. The exam must be completed in one sitting. Students will not be able to complete the exam on another day.

**Q: *How often can I take the TEAS?***

A: You may repeat the exam two times during a calendar year with 30 days between each attempt.

**Q: *How long are the test scores valid?***

A: The TEAS scores are valid for one calendar year.

**Q: *What is the minimum TEAS score required for the BSN program at Wesleyan College?***

A: A minimum exam score reflecting a 75 or higher composite score is required in order to be included in the applicant pool.

**Q: *What sections of the TEAS does Wesleyan College require?***

A: Wesleyan College requires students to take four sections of the TEAS for application to the Nursing Program.

- Reading, English, Math, and Science

**Q: *Is there a recommended study guide for the TEAS?***

A: Yes. [www.atitesting.com/teas-prep](http://www.atitesting.com/teas-prep)

**Q: *What is the test format of the TEAS?***

A: The TEAS is a computer based test only.

**Q: *Can I use a calculator on the TEAS?***

A: Yes. The TEAS has a calculator available inside the test platform for students to use. However, handheld calculators are not permitted.

**Q: *How many questions are there on the TEAS?***

A: 170

**Q: *Where can I get additional information about the TEAS?***

## **TEST TAKING INFORMATION**

**Q: *Who is eligible to sit for the TEAS?***

A: Any person who has applied for admission to Wesleyan College and is planning to apply to the BSN Program.

**Q: *Where can I take the TEAS?***

A: It is offered on Wesleyan College Campus, a testing center, or online remote proctor. It must be the latest version.

**Q: *How do I register for the TEAS?***

A: Information about registration can be found at: <https://wesportal.wesleyancollege.edu/>. It is a separate step from submitting the application.

You can also register at <https://www.atitesting.com/teas/register> in order to take the exam at a testing center or online remote proctor.

**Q: *When will I receive my results?***

A: You can view your test scores at the conclusion of your test session.

**Q: How can I send my results if the TEAS is taken at another location?**

A: You can send transcript by following the instructions at <https://www.atitesting.com/teas/transcript>

**Q: *How do I request reasonable test accommodations for the TEAS?***

A: Contact the Director of Disability & Advocacy Services (Jill Amos, [jamos@wesleyancollege.edu](mailto:jamos@wesleyancollege.edu)) a minimum of three weeks before your testing date to request accommodations. The request needs to be made after you've made your appointment for testing.

**Q: *When is the test offered at Wesleyan College?***
